The following resolution declares a Local State of Emergency in response to Tropical Storm Helene.

RESOLUTION NO. R2024-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Tropical Storm Helene is projected to strengthen and intensify over the next few days, with forecast models indicating this system could develop into a major hurricane before making landfall near Florida's Gulf Coast; and,

WHEREAS, current conditions are projected to bring heavy rainfall to many areas across Florida, potentially effecting Sumter County and the City of Wildwood; and,

WHEREAS, prolonged heavy rainfall and potential damaging floods pose a significant concern for the safety and well-being of citizens of Wildwood; and,

WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order 24-208 on September 23, 2024, declaring a state of emergency for multiple counties, including Sumter; and,

WHEREAS, the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners issued a Local State of Emergency at their meeting on September 24, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, provides authority for a political subdivision such as the City of Wildwood to declare a Local State of Emergency; and,

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined the need to declare a Local State of Emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. The City of Wildwood hereby declares a State of Local Emergency for all areas within the legal limits of the City of Wildwood.
2. The Emergency Operations Plan for the City of Wildwood is hereby activated.
3. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to utilize the City's resources to take the necessary steps to protect the lives and property of the public. Any City regulations prescribing procedures for the conduct of City business, if strict compliance would hinder necessary action in coping with the emergency, are hereby suspended.
4. This Declaration shall remain in effect for a period of ten (10) days unless extended or dissolved.
