A. Local State of Emergency Declaration - Tropical Storm Helene

Mayor Wolf read the title of Resolution No. R2024-25, a resolution declaring a local state of emergency due to the impending hurricane Helen. City Manager McHugh reported that the State of Florida had already declared a state of emergency and Sumter County had declared a local emergency the night before. McHugh stated that staff would be taking all measures of precaution to prevent flooding in Woodlane Meadows. He stated that he would make a decision later in the day as to city facility closures. He would also be holding staff meetings later in the day to discuss storm preparation. McHugh stated that information would be sent out as decisions were made.

Commissioner Elliott commented that he had driven through Woodlane Meadows and noticed that the pumps had been removed. He asked if they were going to be set back up. McHugh indicated that the pumps would once again be placed in Woodlane Meadows. The resolution declaring a local state of emergency was adopted upon motion and second. Vote 5-0.
